

The January 8, 2026, Special Meeting of the Shillington Borough Council was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by President Hoffert for the presentation of the Fire Apparatus Fleet Review and Fire Station Assessment completed by Emergency Vehicle Response (EVR), as advertised. Council members in attendance were: Dr. Elizabeth M. Bentz, Nicholas M. Bentz, Mark C. Grounard, John W. Hoffert, Michael A. Hoffert, Jared A. Hopgood, and Ronald R. Klee, Jr. Present in addition to Council members were: Mayor Andrew R. Hivner, Police Chief Brett A. Hivner, Borough Manager Scott D. Brossman, Solicitor Thomas L. Klonis, Fire Chief David Bentz, Jan M. Boyd, Secretary Kristen M. Schlottman, as well as several members of the Mohnton Borough Council. Members of the Shillington Borough Fire Department, Mohnton Borough Fire Department, and several neighboring municipal fire departments were also in attendance.

Following a brief introduction by Fire Chief David Bentz, Mr. Michael K. Wilbur, of EVR began his review of the report he prepared, which was previously provided to Council Members and other Borough officials. Mr. Wilbur highlighted several specific areas of his report including the status of apparatus in both the Shillington and Mohnton Fire Departments, the condition of both Fire stations, current staffing levels of both departments, and other items observed during his period of consultation with both boroughs. At the conclusion of Mr. Wilbur's presentation, several member's of Council and the public addressed questions to Mr. Wilbur regarding his report.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned upon motion of Ronald R. Klee, Jr., at 7:33 p.m.
